NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

TO: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WOODLANDS ROAD UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of The Woodlands Road Utility District No. 1 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, April 15, 2024, at 10:00 a.m.**, at 2455 Lake Robbins Drive, The Woodlands, Texas, outside the boundaries of the District, for the following purposes:

1. Receive comments from the public;
2. Review and approval of minutes of the March 25, 2024, special meeting of the Board of Directors;
3. Consider and act upon the engineer's report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts, and the acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission Form 1295;
 - (b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates or change orders; and
 - (c) Status of the Woodlands Parkway at Grogan's Mill Road intersection project, including the approval of any proposals, pay estimates and/or change orders in connection therewith;
4. Consider and act upon developer's report;
5. Status of proposed annexation of lands to and/or the exclusion of lands from the boundaries of the District and authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
6. Consider and act upon reports from the District's attorney, financial advisor and tax assessor/collector;
7. Consider and act upon financial and investment reports, and approval and/or ratification of the payment of invoices;
8. Review of Arbitrage Maintenance Report prepared by Municipal Risk Management Group, LLC, relative to the District's bonds;
9. Consider approval of Engagement Letter for Compliance Services from Arbitrage Compliance Specialists, Inc., for preparation of (i) Fifth Year Arbitrage Rebate

Report for the District's \$13,075,000 Unlimited Tax Road Refunding Bonds, Series 2016, (ii) Fifth Year Arbitrage Rebate Report for the District's \$14,640,000 Unlimited Tax Road Refunding Bonds, Series 2019, and (iii) Yield Restriction Report for the District's \$14,640,000 Unlimited Tax Road Refunding Bonds, Series 2019;


10. Recess to closed session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code;
