
## THE WOODLANDS ROAD UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of The Woodlands Road Utility District No. 1 will hold a special meeting on <u>Monday, December 5, 2022, at 10:00 a.m.</u>, at 2455 Lake Robbins Drive, The Woodlands, Texas, outside the boundaries of the District, for the following purposes:

- 1. Receive comments from the public;
- 2. Review and approval of minutes of the October 31, 2022, special meeting of the Board of Directors;
- 3. Consider and act upon the engineer's report, including:
  - a. Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts, and the acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission Form 1295;
  - b. Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates or change orders;
  - c. Update regarding development of mobility improvement options for Research Forest Drive at Grogan's Mill Road intersection and/or Lake Woodlands Drive at Grogan's Mill Road intersection; and
  - d. Receive and discuss list of Proposed Future District Projects;
- 4. Consider and act upon developer's report;
- 5. Status of proposed annexation of lands to and/or the exclusion of lands from the boundaries of the District and authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
- 6. Consider and act upon reports from the District's attorney, financial advisor and tax assessor/collector;
- 7. Consider, discuss, and take appropriate action regarding termination of Tax Abatement Agreement between the District, The Woodlands Land Development Company, L.P. ("TWLDC") and Alight Solutions, LLC, as assigned by TWLDC to 8770 New Trails Holdings, LLC;
- 8. Consider and act upon financial and investment reports, and approval and/or ratification of the payment of invoices;
- 9. Recess to closed session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code;

- 10. Reconvene in open session and authorize any action resulting from closed session; and
- 11. Such other matters as may come before the Board of Directors.
