- 11. Consider and act upon reports from the District's attorney, financial advisor and tax assessor/collector;

- 12. Consider and act upon financial and investment reports, and approval and/or ratification of the payment of invoices;
- 13. Consider and act upon approval and adoption of a budget for the District's fiscal year ending September 30, 2026;
- 14. Consider and act upon engaging auditor for preparation of the District's audit and House Bill 1378 financial report for fiscal year ending September 30, 2025;
- 15. Annual review of Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution in connection therewith;
- 16. Adoption of Resolution Adopting List of Qualified Brokers Authorized to Engage in Investment Transactions with District;
- 17. Recess to closed session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code;
- 18. Reconvene in open session and authorize any action resulting from closed session; and
- 19. Such other matters as may come before the Board of Directors.
