NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

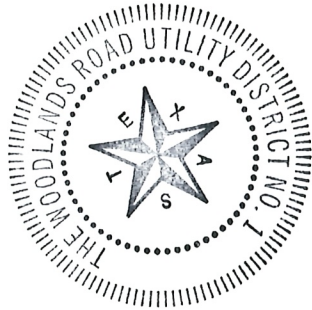

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of The Woodlands Road Utility District No. 1 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, May 18, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.**, at 2455 Lake Robbins Drive, The Woodlands, Texas, outside the boundaries of the District, for the following purposes:

1. Receive comments from the public;
2. Review and approval of minutes of the April 20, 2026, meeting of the Board of Directors;
3. Acceptance of Qualification Statements, Bonds, Oaths of Office, Affidavits of Current Director and Elections Not to Disclose Information for Directors Blair, Sutton and Hannon;
4. Election of officers of Board of Directors;
5. Approval of District Registration Form relative to election of Directors;
6. Authorize preparation and maintenance of a local government officers list in connection with conflict of interest disclosure requirements;
7. Consider and act upon the engineer's report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts, and the acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission Form 1295; and
 - (b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates or change orders, including:
 - 1) Woodlands Parkway at Grogan's Mill Road Intersection Project;
8. Discuss Montgomery County synchronization of traffic signals in Town Center area and authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
9. Consider and act upon developer's report;
10. Status of proposed annexation of lands to and/or the exclusion of lands from the boundaries of the District and authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;


11. Consider and act upon reports from the District's attorney, financial advisor and tax assessor/collector;
12. Consider and act upon financial and investment reports, and approval and/or ratification of the payment of invoices;
13. Discuss changes to cybersecurity and artificial intelligence training requirements applicable to directors of the District;

15. Reconvene in open session and authorize any action resulting from closed session; and
16. Such other matters as may come before the Board of Directors.
