NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

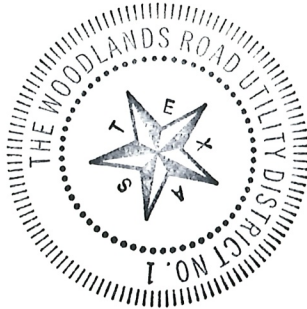
TO: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WOODLANDS ROAD UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 AND TO ALL OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of The Woodlands Road Utility District No. 1 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, June 15, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.**, at 2455 Lake Robbins Drive, The Woodlands, Texas, outside the boundaries of the District, for the following purposes:

1. Receive comments from the public;
2. Review and approval of minutes of the May 18, 2026, meeting of the Board of Directors;
3. Consider and act upon the engineer's report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts, and the acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission Form 1295; and
 - (b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates or change orders, including:
 - 1) Woodlands Parkway at Grogan's Mill Road Intersection Project;
4. Discuss Montgomery County synchronization of traffic signals in Town Center area and authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
5. Consider and act upon developer's report;
6. Status of proposed annexation of lands to and/or the exclusion of lands from the boundaries of the District and authorize any action necessary in connection therewith;
7. Consider and act upon reports from the District's attorney, financial advisor and tax assessor/collector;
8. Authorize completion, execution and filing with the Secretary of State of Voting System Annual Filing Form relative to District elections;
9. Request from Records Management Officer to destroy certain records of the District;
10. Status of compliance with annual cybersecurity training as required by Chapters 2054 and 2063, Texas Government Code;
11. Consider and act upon financial and investment reports, and approval and/or ratification of the payment of invoices;

12. Recess to closed session pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code;
13. Reconvene in open session and authorize any action resulting from closed session;
and
14. Such other matters as may come before the Board of Directors.
